NOTICE of Republican Town

Caucuses:

All Town Clerks,
All Republican Town Chairs, and
All Republicans Voters

in the state of Vermont are hereby notified in accordance of 17 V.S.A. § 2302, that

The Republican Party's State Chair, Deb Billado has set the date for our party's statewide organization caucuses to be held on:

Tuesday, September 17th

in a public place within each respective town at a time and location to be determined by either the acting Republican Town Chair, or if in the absence of an acting chair, by any three voters registered to vote in that town.

The Town Chairs, or three registered voters shall also be required to give public

notice of the time and location of their particular caucus to the state party, and according to 17 V.S.A. § 2303.

The purpose of these caucuses will be to elect a new town committee for each town. Once a town committee has been elected, the caucuses will adjourn, and the new town committee shall hold its first meeting immediately after the caucus adjournment. The town committee shall then proceed to elect its officers, and a number of delegates from each town to their county committee. At the conclusion the Chair & Secretary of that Town Committee shall report the results to the state party and the county chair within 72 hours of its completion.
