TOWN OF HIGHGATE TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Sections 1007 and 1008, Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Sections 1971 and 2291 and such other general enactments as may be material hereto, it is hereby ordained by the Selectboard of the Town of Highgate that the following Traffic Ordinance is adopted as a civil ordinance for the Town of Highgate, Vermont.

ARTICLE | DEFINITIONS

The definitions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 4 are incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE II SCOPE

The ordinance establishes special traffic regulations on public highways within the Town of Highgate, Vermont.

ARTICLE III TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

Section 1

It shall be unlawful for any person to disobey the direction of a traffic control device except in response to the direction of a law enforcement officer.

Section 2

It shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally remove, injure, obstruct, deface, alter or tamper with any traffic control device.

Section 3

It shall be unlawful for any person to install any sign or device, which may resemble or be mistaken for an official traffic control device, without prior approval of the Town of Highgate Selectboard.

ARTICLE IV SPEED REGULATIONS

On the basis of engineering and traffic surveys, the following speed limits are hereby established;

The above speed limits shall be posted in accordance with the standards set forth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and shall be in effect when so posted. Roads not otherwise posted shall be limited to 50 mph.

ARTICLE VI PARKING REGULATIONS

Section 1

It shall be unlawful to park at any time on either side of the following roads:

GORE ROAD FROM THE LAMOILLE VALLEY RAILROAD THROUGH THE AREA IN FRONT OF THE HIGHGATE SPORTS ARENA

Section 2

Any vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of this Article may be summarily removed at the owner's expense, by order of any law enforcement officer, Town Constable or Selectboard member.

If the owner of a vehicle summarily removed under Section 2 hereof does not claim such vehicle and pay all towing and storage expenses within thirty (30) days of the date of such removal, the title to such vehicle may be sold or otherwise disposed of in accordance with Title 27, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 11.

Nothing in this Article shall be construed to make unlawful vehicular stops in obedience to the direction of a law enforcement officer or for causes beyond the control of the operator.

ARTICLE VII LOADED VEHICLES

No vehicle shall be driven or moved on any street unless such vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to prevent its contents from dropping, sifting, leaking or otherwise escaping there from.

ARTICLE VIII ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

This ordinance incorporates Title 23 Vermont Statutes Annotated, Chapter 31 as it pertains to the operation of All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV).

ARTICLE IX GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1.

Enforcement

This ordinance is adopted as a civil ordinance and will be enforced as such pursuant to the provisions of Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Sections 1974a and 1977.

Separate Offenses

Each violation of a provision of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense. The provisions of this ordinance shall be cumulative to the fullest extent permitted by law with respect to all other statutes or ordinances now or hereafter adopted regardless of their order of passage or enactment.

Severability

The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable and if any provision hereof be judged invalid, such judgment shall not affect the validity of any provision.

Designation

This ordinance may be referred to as the Highgate Traffic Ordinance and in a prosecution here under a copy of such ordinance, certified by the Town Clerk, shall be prima facie evidence thereof. An allegation that the act constituting the offense charged is contrary to a specified provision of this ordinance shall be a sufficient reference hereto.

Repeal of Prior Ordinance

Any other ordinance or traffic regulation heretofore adopted by the Town of Highgate is hereby repealed.

AMENDMENT V

Article VII of this ordinance is hereby amended to include the following:

- 1) No vehicle shall be driven or moved on any street unless such vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to prevent its contents from dropping, shifting, leaking or otherwise escaping there from.
- In consideration of neighborhood character, abutting land use, bicycle and pedestrian use and physical characteristics of the highways, no commercial trucks exceeding 24,000 pounds (registered weight) shall be allowed on TH31 (Cross Street) and TH21 (Decatur Street), with the exception of seasonal agricultural vehicles and local delivery vehicles.
