Eligibility Criteria

Have you become homeless in the past 90 days or are you about to be evicted from your housing?

- Served in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard on active duty after basic training
- At any time or era from WWII till today
- Have other than a dishonorable discharge
- Have very low, extremely low or no income
