

**ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**MISSISQUOI VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
**March 3, 2020**

**ARTICLE I** To elect from the legal voters of said District the following officers:

- A. A Moderator for a term of one year  
Tim Magnant was voted in with 2224 votes. Total votes cast 2415 votes with 174 undervotes/blank ballots and 17 write-ins.
  
- B. A Clerk for a term of one year  
Nola Gilbert was voted in with 2162 votes. Total votes cast 2415 votes with 240 undervotes/blank ballots and 13 write- ins.
  
- C. A Treasurer for a term of one year  
Georgette Roddy was voted in with 2195 votes. Total votes cast 2415 votes with 210 undervotes/blank ballots and 10 write- ins.
  
- D. A MVSD School Director for a term of three (3) years from Franklin  
Joanne Johnston was voted in with 202 votes (write-in). Total votes cast 2415 votes with 2052 undervotes/blank ballots and 161 additional write-in votes.
  
- E. A MVSD School Director for a term of three (3) years from Highgate  
Steven Scott was voted in with 2033 votes. Total votes cast 2415 votes with 371 undervotes/blank ballots and 11 write ins.
  
- F. A MVSD School Director for a term of three (3) years from Swanton.  
Theresa (Terri) O'Shea was voted in with 2084 votes. Total votes cast 2415 votes with 316 undervotes/blank ballots and 15 write- ins.

**ARTICLE II:** Shall the voters authorize the Board of School Directors to make available school facilities and equipment for specified public purposes if those purposes appear to be in the best interest of the residents of the District, due consideration being given to efficient, economical and appropriate use of the facilities and equipment?

The Article Passed with 2044 in favor, 239 against and 132 undervotes/blank ballots out of 2415 total votes.

**ARTICLE III :** Shall the voters of the Missisquoi Valley School District approve the School Directors to expend \$37,906,229 which is the amount the School Directors have determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year?

It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$15,626 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 2.6% higher than spending for the current year.

The Article Passed with 1225 in favor, 1049 against and 141 undervotes/blank ballots out of 2415 total votes.

**ARTICLE IV:** Shall the voters of the Missisquoi Valley School District authorize the Board of Directors of the said School District to borrow money to pay the current expenditures in anticipation of taxes and to sign notes for that purpose?

The Article Passed with 1489 in favor, 784 against and 142 undervotes/blank ballots out of 2415 total votes.
